In the event of any conflict between these bylaws and the articles of association, these bylaws shall govern.

**★★ARTICLE III: PURPOSES**

**Section 1:** The Objects (Purposes) of the association, in common with the Objects of the National PTA are:

- To promote the welfare of children and youth in the home, school, community and place of worship.
- To raise the standards of home life.
- To secure adequate laws for the care and protection of children and youth.
- To bring into closer relation the home and the school, that parents and teachers may cooperate intelligently in the education of children and youth.
- To develop between educators and the general public such united efforts as will secure for all children and youth the highest advantages in physical, mental, social and spiritual education.

**Section 2.** The Objects of this association are promoted in cooperation with the state PTA and the National PTA, through an education-

**Section 3.** The association is organized exclusively for the charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding Section of any future Federal tax code (hereinafter "Internal Revenue Code").

**★★ARTICLE IV: BASIC POLICIES**

The following are basic policies of this association.

- The association shall be noncommercial, nonsectarian and nonpartisan.
- The name of the association or the names of any members in their official capacities shall not be used to endorse or promote a commercial concern or in connection with any partisan interest or for any purpose not appropriately related to promotion of the Purposes of the association.
- The association shall not, directly or indirectly, participate or intervene (in any way, including the publishing or distributing of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; or devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise.
- The association shall work with the schools to provide quality education for all children and youth and shall seek to participate in the decision-making process establishing school policy, recognizing that the legal responsibilities to make decisions has been delegated by the people to boards of education.
- The association shall not enter into membership with other organizations except such international or national organizations
